














# Torah Trope

## BASIC TORAH TROPE GROUPS

Tropes (or te'amim, meaning "flavor" or "taste") tell us many things about the groupings such as:

- (1) Music (2) Accents (3) Punctuation and Phrasing

In the examples below, the box indicates the Hebrew word. Notice that some tropes appear under a word, and some appear on top. The group takes its name from the last trope in that group.
