

Paper Kippah (yarmulke) Craft



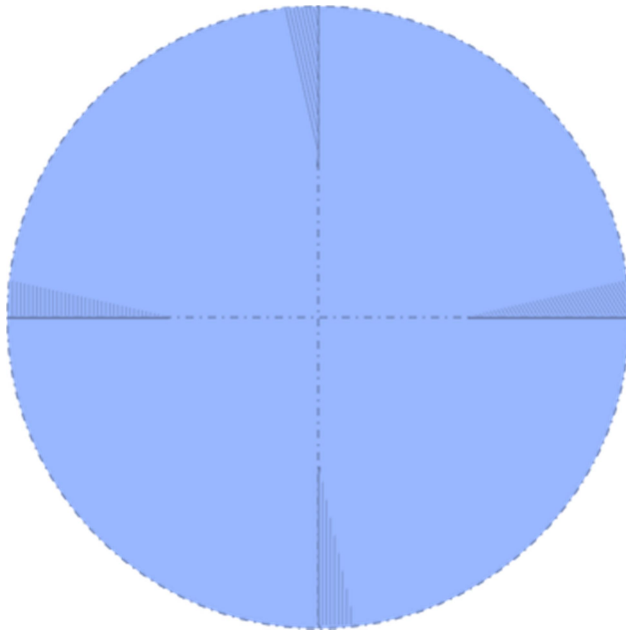
You will need:

- paper or small paper plate
- a small plate to trace around, unless you're using a plate for the kippah
- scissors
- tape
- decorating materials (markers, stickers etc.)

First, draw a circle on a piece of paper or small (7") paper plate, which makes quite a large kippah. If your child wants to wear the finished product, you might need to make it a little smaller.

Next, decorate the inside of your circle.

Now cut out the circle, and fold it in half, then into quarters. Unfold it again. You will need to cut halfway along each of the four lines you have just made in the paper. (See where the lines are on the image below).



Once you have made your cuts, gently overlap the two edges of each cut (as per the green shaded area above, adjusting it to the shape you want) and secure it with tape. And that's all there is to it!
