Positions:

- **President** is responsible for delegating duties and supporting the Vice Presidents and Student Council projects. The President is the liaison between the TBAHigh Administration/Faculty and the Student Council Exec Board. The President is expected to be in close communication with TBAHigh Supervisor. The President oversees all aspects of Student Council programs and follows up with VPs to ensure all planning and implementation assignments are completed. The President will act as a grade representative. The President creates an agenda for Executive Board Meetings and leads them every Tuesday from 8:00-8:30 pm to discuss and review prior events and committee updates for upcoming programs. On Leadership nights enroll in Student Council Elective and act as liaison to the Programming & Kehillah Committees by attending their meetings.
- **Executive Vice President** is responsible for stepping in as leader whenever the President is unable to be present. Other duties include overseeing Student Outreach by meeting and engaging with all students to foster Kehillah, employing social media to promote TBAHigh programs, organizing pizza schedule and reminding the appropriate VP each week so committees can be contacted at least one day prior. Exec VP attends Executive Board Meetings every Tuesday from 8:00-8:30 pm to discuss and review prior events and committee updates for upcoming programs. The Exec VP will act as a grade representative. On Leadership nights enroll in Student Council Elective and act as liaison to the Social Action & Cultural Committees by attending their meetings.
- **Programming Vice President** plans, reviews and evaluates the Tochniyot (large-scale programs). On Leadership nights PVP leads the Programming Committee Meeting with advisor to learn how to create programs by reviewing, evaluating and improving the Tochniyot. This committee will help plan the final Tochnit. The PVP will serve as the liaison between the advisors and Student Council Exec Board and act as a grade representative. PVP attends Executive Board Meetings every Tuesday from 8:00-8:30 pm to discuss and review prior events and committee updates for upcoming programs. On Leadership nights enroll in Student Council Elective.
- **Cultural Vice President** is responsible for Jewish cultural programming at TBAHigh. Responsibilities include working with the clergy, TBAHigh staff and the Cultural Committee to prepare for holiday celebrations, the Teen High Holiday service, Teen Shabbat Services and Havdalah for Erev Machane and the 9th Grade Retreat, leading Hanukkah blessings during TBAHigh dinner etc. The CVP will contact and meet with the clergy to gain skills to lead these services. The CVP works with Student Council to bring Judaism into every facet of TBAHigh. The CVP serves as a grade representative. CVP will meet with the Executive Board of Student Council every Tuesday from 8:00-8:30 pm to discuss and review prior events and committee updates for upcoming programs and lead the CVP Committee Meeting on Chug Leadership nights. On Leadership nights enroll in Student Council Elective.
- **Social Action Vice President** develops opportunities and encourages participation in Social Action at TBAHigh and Temple Beth Ami. SAVP works with the advisor and TBAHigh Supervisor to plan, advertise and lead Social Action Programs. On Leadership nights the SAVP leads the Social Action Committee Meeting. SAVP attends Executive Board Meeting every Tuesday from 8:00-8:30 pm to discuss and review prior events and committee updates for upcoming programs. SAVP acts as a grade representative. On Leadership nights enroll in Student Council Elective.
- **Kehillah Vice President** plans, advertises and encourages participation in engaging TBAHigh Kehillah events and programs. KVP leads and attends the TBAHigh Kehillah events. This committee also promotes NFTY and BBYO events. On Leadership nights KVP leads Kehillah Committee Meeting. KVP attends Executive Board Meeting every Tuesday from 8:00-8:30 pm to discuss and review prior events and committee updates for upcoming programs. On Leadership nights enroll in Student Council Elective.
