



Flower Crowns

You will need:

- flowers and leaves collected fresh from the garden or neighborhood
- heavy construction paper (card stock is best)
- double sided tape (if you don't have this you can use regular tape as well.)
- scissors
- stapler

How to:

Prepare the card stock by cutting it into strips and then stapling two strips together to make one long one. Strips are approx 8cm (just over 3") in height, and each crown needed two strips to go around your head. Older kids may need it to be slightly longer.

Double sided tape:

Place double sided tape along the strips to create a sticky surface. Leave the paper backing on the strips until you are ready to do the sticking.

Once you have collected some flowers and leaves, take the backing off of the double-sided tape. Press your flowers and leaves onto the double-sided tape.

Clear tape:

Once you have collected some flowers and leaves, lay them out on the strips of paper in the order you want them.

Take a clear piece of tape and secure each flower and leaf to the cardstock.

Once you have finished with the tape, connect the two ends of the paper so that they form a circle that fits around your head.
