Your gift to the following funds will be invested in an endowment fund managed by TBA's Endowment Investment Committee. This committee will determine an annual allocation of invested funds to be used for each fund's designated purposes:

SUSTAINING (GENERAL) ENDOWMENT FUND

To support the future of the congregation. A percentage of the invested funds will be allocated annually to support the congregation's operating budget.
