Legal Services



JCADA's legal team provides direct representation to survivors of Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) who are seeking Protective Orders (POs), primarily in the courts of Montgomery County, MD and Fairfax County, VA.



Victim Advocacy Services

JCADA's victim advocates empower survivors of IPV by helping them meet their basic needs for food, shelter, clothing, transportation, and safety. Our team serves survivors of IPV who have case management needs and are currently receiving legal or clinical services at JCADA.



Clinical Services

JCADA's licensed clinicians support survivors of IPV in the Greater Washington, DC area who are currently experiencing trauma-related symptoms that interfere with their ability to live safe and empowered lives.



Education Services

JCADA's education team teaches the diverse Jewish community in the Greater Washington, DC area about the dynamics of both healthy and abusive relationships. Our team works to reduce the tolerance of abuse within Jewish spaces, and to increase support for survivors of IPV within the Jewish community.
