



Camp Scholarships in Memory of Harriet Sturm, z"l

to attend TBA & URJ Summer Camps

For the summer of 2026, Women of Temple Beth Ami (WTBA) and the TBA Brotherhood are excited to offer a limited number of scholarships for children to attend summer camp programs at either **Temple Beth Ami (TBA)** or a **Union for Reform Judaism (URJ)-affiliated camp**. **Please note that these are the only camps for which the scholarships are available.** Information about URJ camps can be found at <http://urj.org/what-we-do/engaging-youth-families-young-children/camp>. These scholarships are named in memory of Harriet Sturm, z"l, past-president of WTBA and life-long champion of the youth programs of Reform Judaism.

Due to budgetary constraints, please only request this scholarship if it would be a financial hardship on your family for your child to attend the camp without this monetary assistance.

Children and grandchildren of WTBA and Brotherhood members, who also belong to TBA, will be given first consideration.

Funding Information:

- All applicants must be members in good standing of TBA to be considered for a scholarship.
- This scholarship is need-based so that all children may have a chance to have a camp experience.
- Funds are available for the following programs:
 - TBA's Gan Ami summer program or Kayitz (Machane TBA summer camp) – up to \$300/child
 - A URJ - affiliated summer camp –up to \$750/child
- All scholarship money will be sent directly to the organizations, not to the families.
- Applications will be reviewed with priority consideration given as follows:
 - First consideration will be given to children of WTBA and/or TBA Brotherhood members.
 - Second consideration will be given to children currently enrolled in TBA Gan Ami, their grade level in MachaneTBA, or TBAHigh.
 - Third consideration will be given to children who are not currently enrolled in TBA Gan Ami, MachaneTBA, or TBAHigh but who are active members in a community-based Jewish organization. Students must write a statement with a description of their involvement in that organization.
